

PRIVACY POLICY – THE REP COMPANY

THE REP COMPANY IS BEING SET UP TO PROVIDE TRAINING THROUGH PERFORMANCE

The aim is for members of the Company to gain experience not only in performance, but will learn some of the technical aspects of theatre, such as lighting, sound, stage management. There will be performances which will include a Shakespeare Production, a Farce, an Agatha Christie Play, a Musical, a Devised piece, and a Radio Play. For the purpose of training - videos/recordings will be made, so that the production techniques can be seen and improved. These will not be shown to the general public and will not be released to any other person or organization.

We are compliant with the new GDPR in force from 25th May 2018 and ensure that we protect the company members' private data. Our Privacy Policy has been written so that people of all ages can understand what information we will hold and how we will use this information. We will never sell your information but we may have to share some information with other professional bodies, who will make sure are also GDPR Compliant. This could include Casting Directors, Production Companies, prospective Agents or Lawyers who may need to arrange contracts etc.

We take your privacy seriously and so the only data we will take is that which is necessary for us to conduct the training effectively.

The Data will be collected via an Application form and will be kept until after the auditions and places have been offered and accepted. At which point the data of the unsuccessful candidates will be destroyed. Data of the successful candidates will be kept securely locked away and our computer data securely protected. At the end of the course we will ask you if you wish us to still keep your data for 3 months in case we need to contact you, but at the end of that time the data will be destroyed.

We have Safe Guarding Policies in place and will employ industry professionals who are DBS Checked to conduct the training.
